

## KS2 mathematics work sheet: one- and two-step addition and subtraction

1. There were 192 bricks on one pallet, and 96 bricks on another pallet. 128 bricks were taken by builders to use on a home.



How many bricks were left on the pallets?

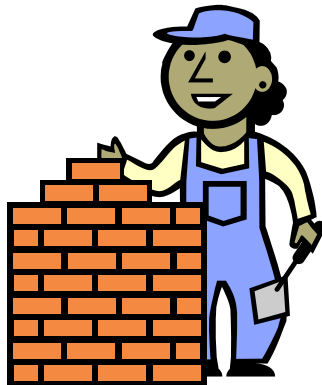
2. When working on a building site, people use a lot of nails. A box of nails holds 100 nails when it's full. There are 7 full boxes of nails. The builders take 452 nails to be used while they work.



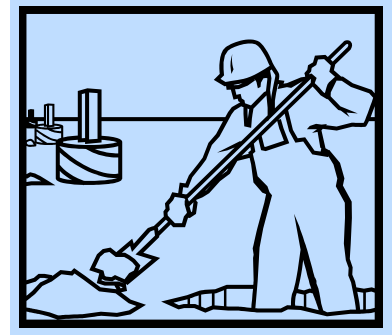
How many nails are left?

3. There are 122 bricklayers, 98 carpenters and 75 electricians on the building site.

How many workers are there in total on the building site?



4. There are currently only 205 workers on the building site and 78 workers come to join them. 117 workers then go off the site on their lunch break.



How many workers are there left on the building site?

5. The workers build 302 houses on one part of the site and 123 houses on another part of the site. 279 houses have already been bought by families.



How many have not been bought yet?

6. 140 children were visiting the building site on a school trip. Half the children went to talk to the builders. 35 more children went to join them.

How many children were talking to the builders?
